Lenten Practices of Our Members and Friends

The practice of keeping Lent for forty days prior to Easter has a long tradition. It was implemented by the bishops of the early church in the fourth century to help us get back to basics, to do less, and to do with less. In our own time, we might cut back on certain foods or comforts. We might also add some hours of service or study and give "extra" in terms of volunteering or making a financial contribution.

Last month I had asked about the particular Lenten practice you intend to keep this season. Here are some examples you submitted. Thank you to all those who provided us with inspiration and spiritual creativity!

I'm sure as you read through these practices, you will be as amazed and encouraged as I am.

Here they are:

- --I will daily read the scriptures.
- --I will increase my time of mediation.
- --I will eat healthy.
- --I will spend half an hour daily listening to God.
- --I will read the Upper Room devotional guide daily.
- --I will do a liquid fast once a week.
- --I will change the way I feed my body so as to eat sacrificially rather than indulgently.
- --I will be giving up my views on politics.
- --I will become more aware of God's presence in my daily life.
- --I will make more time for daily Bible reading and prayer.

--I will be less negative about people's short-comings.

--I will be practicing healthier eating and exercise daily.

--I will write a personal note of encouragement to people in my life at least five days per week.

--I will spend more time reading and studying the Bible since I am not as self disciplined as I could be.

--I will spend as much time with the Bible as I do playing games on my phone. This will be a real challenge for me!
