Dear Friends,

The joy of the resurrection is grounded in our faith in eternal life. If we trust that Christ has been raised and that we and our loved ones in Christ will be with him, then Easter and these next forty days are filled with meaning. But, according to the church father Ignatius of Antioch, if we sever daily life from our walk with Christ, if we praise him with one half of our mouth while making a sour face with the other, then we are worshiping Christ only half-way and are only a half-way Easter people. Let's not sever what we believe from how we act and let the joy of the resurrected life and its hope permeate our entire being.

We begin the month with the **Men's Breakfast on Sunday, April 7 at 7 a.m.** The men cook their own breakfast and afterwards study the preaching text of the day with the pastor. It's also Communion Sunday in worship.



On **Sunday, April 14,** I will be on study leave and the Rev. Brent Folkema will be preaching. My time will be spent in Brazil with visits to museums, churches, and the Christ the Redeemer statue in Rio de Janeiro. While I'll be back in worship on April 21, I will not be teaching a class in April. We will resume adult education in May, with the ongoing study of the writings of the Apostle Paul.

During these forty days of the Easter season, may the risen Christ make himself known to you fully, as he did to his disciples. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!
